




Welcome to **Bacalar**The Mexican **Paradise!**

WHERE IS BACALAR LOCATED?

Bacalar is a charming small town nestled in the southern region of Quintana Roo, Mexico. It graces the shores of the stunning Bacalar Lagoon, often referred to as the "Lagoon of the Seven Colors" for its mesmerizing blend of blue and green hues. This enchanting lagoon stands as Bacalar's prime tourist attraction, offering an idyllic setting for aquatic adventures like swimming, snorkeling, kayaking, paddleboarding, and leisurely boat excursions. Additionally, the vicinity boasts several captivating cenotes, making it a popular hub for diving and snorkeling enthusiasts.



THE MAYAN TRAIN

The Tren Maya is an expansive railway infrastructure endeavor presently in progress within Mexico. This innovative train will traverse the Yucatan Peninsula, journeying through the states of Quintana Roo, Yucatan, Campeche, Tabasco, and Chiapas.

This ambitious project is currently underway and is anticipated to reach completion by 2024. The Tren Maya's route will span an impressive 1,525 kilometers and encompass 15 stations, including renowned tourist destinations like Tulum, Playa del Carmen, Cancun, Palenque, and Chichen Itza, among others.




TULUM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT


This airport, also recognized as the Riviera Maya International Airport, stands among the nation's latest aviation hubs. It's conveniently located around 10 kilometers from Tulum and approximately 100 kilometers from Cancun. Sporting a solitary terminal, it boasts the capability to accommodate up to 3 million passengers each year. Tulum International Airport serves as a gateway for both domestic and international flights, with a primary focus on connecting travelers to destinations in North America, Central America, and Europe. Additionally, it serves as a favored point of entry for visitors exploring the wonders of the Riviera Maya, including renowned locales like Cancun, Playa del Carmen, and Cozumel.



ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONE OF ICHKABAL

Near the Bacalar Lagoon is Ichkabal, a Mayan city that is older than Chichén Itzá and Uxmal. The great political center and most important city of the Maya in the Yucatán Peninsula, it was accidentally discovered in 1995 but remained closed because it is so extensive that it could not be adequately protected. The ruins of Ichkabal are located in the southern part of Quintana Roo, specifically in the municipality of Bacalar, 40 kilometers west of the Bacalar Lagoon and 9 kilometers northeast of Dzibanché, forming a circuit of Maya monuments along with Kinichna and Kohulich. What is curious about this case is that the monumental structures of this city were covered by dense jungle growth, making their discovery difficult during other periods of significant archaeological finds.

A thorough and precise planning process has been carried out to accommodate 36 artisanal villas, ranging in size from 102 to 145 square meters each.

These villas collectively occupy an area of 20,000 square meters, accounting for only 30% of the total land. This approach ensures the conservation of the local vegetation and wildlife.
